Dear Colleagues,

Simulated Surgical Laboratories (Wetlabs) have now come of an age and are accepted as the best way for surgeons to familiarise themselves with the operating microscope, micro-instrumentation and machinery prior to performing Ophthalmic microsurgery on patients. I hope that the days when the first time you used a new knife or Phacomachine on a patient's eye have gone as it is now possible to perfect your incisions, capsulorhexis, phacoemulsification, vitrectomy etc. on pig's eyes in a controlled simulated surgical environment.

At the WinterAcademy you can learn and experiment without the worry that a patient is going to suffer from your mistakes. The faculty, at the WinterAcademy, are dedicated to helping delegates learn and master the surgical skills necessary to perform their surgery safely on patients. We welcome any colleagues who would like to develop or improve their skills in phacoemulsification and vitrectomy, to consider joining us in Schruns between March 26th and 31st March, 2017 in Schruns/Austria.

We have moved into an era in which surgeons will perform the entire cataract operation through a sub 2mm incision including insertion of the IOL. Toric lenses obviate the need for corneal surgery for the correction of astigmatism. The more sophisticated our surgery the more we must practice.

In addition to learning and perfecting microsurgical skills delegates will also have the opportunity to enjoy the friendly environment of the WinterAcademy and meet and exchange ideas and experiences with the other delegates and faculty. At last year's WinterAcademy we had 70 delegates from 9 different countries all of whom returned home with new surgical skills. I hope that the 2017 WinterAcademy will be an equally rewarding experience for the faculty and delegates.

- Phaco and Vitrectomy
 - The Wetlab on Phacoemulsification will teach techniques of cataract wound construction (clear cornea, corneal, scleral tunnel), capsulorhexis (needle, forceps, Klöti) removal of the cataractous lens (Phaco-Chop, Divide and Conquer, Phaco-Flip, Paediatric Cataract) IOL folding and insertion (Acrylic, Silicone, Polyhema). Management of complications (capsule breaks, vitreous loss, dropped nucleus, small pupils, hard lenses, subluxated lenses) will be thoroughly covered as well as topics such as lens exchange and piggy back lenses.
- easyPhaco® CO-MICS is expected to become the technique of the future, opening the path to ever smaller incisions. Early experts will teach this highly attractive subject.
- **Posterior Vitrectomy** will be taught to a very high standard in specialised Wetlabs. The new indications and techniques of surgery for macular diseases will be taught by one of the innovators of this new surgery.
- Free practice

 Participants can practice established techniques on pig's eyes in their own time or experiment with their own untried ideas. A faculty member will be available to give advice and supervision.
