- **Phaco**

The Wetlab on Phacoemulsification will teach techniques of cataract wound construction (clear cornea, corneal, scleral tunnel), capsulorhexis (needle, forceps, Klöti) removal of the cataractous lens (Phaco-Chop, Divide and Conquer, Phaco-Flip, Paediatric Cataract) IOL folding and insertion (Acrylic, Silicone, Polyhema). Management of complications (capsule breaks, vitreous loss, dropped nucleus, small pupils, hard lenses, subluxated lenses) will be thoroughly covered as well as topics such as lens exchange and piggy back lenses.

- **easyPhaco® CO-MICS**

easyPhaco® is the most advanced phaco technology today, opening the path to even smaller incisions. This fluidics concept delivers unprecedented chamber stability, perfect emulsification and efficient fragment aspiration.

- **Posterior Vitrectomy** will be taught to a very high standard in specialised Wetlabs.

The new indications and techniques of surgery for macular diseases will be taught by one of the innovators of this new surgery.

- **Free practice**

Participants can practice established techniques on pig's eyes in their own time or experiment with their own untried ideas. A faculty member will be available to give advice and supervision.
